**Growing Tips:**

Self-cleaning, no deadheading necessary.

**Exposure:** Partial shade or shade

**Height:** 6-10"

**Spacing:** 8-12"

**Hardy Temp:** 30°F (-1°C)

Plant alone or in combinations in all container types or in landscapes.

**Features:**

Heat and shade tolerant; snapdragon-like flowers all season; low maintenance; attracts hummingbirds; deer resistant.

**Growing Tips for CATALINA®**

- Prefers warmer production temperatures; cold, wet conditions can stunt growth.
- Light shade is best for optimal growth.
- Needs 200 ppm fertilizer.
- Application of Florel® delays flowering 8-10 weeks. However, this is not the case in California.
- Best for 4" production.
- Bronze foliage can be indicative of too high light in production and/or too cold of temperatures. Bronzing will not go away, and plants must grow new foliage without the damage.

**Additional Culture Information for CATALINA®**

pH/EC:	5.5 - 6.2 / .6 - .9
Growing Temperature:	65-72°/70-75°
Holding Temperature:	70-75° outdoors
Water Requirements:	Moderate to Moist
Planting and Timing:	Spring through Summer Finish. Standard Plants Per Pot.
Finish Times in Weeks:	For 4-5", 4-6; for 6"/gallon, 5-7; for 8", 7-9; for 10-12", 10-12
Spring Outdoor Finish:	Do not finish outside

**Notes:**

For pots 6" and smaller, pinch at transplanting only. For hanging baskets pots larger than 6", soft pinch at planting, additional pinches to shape can be used. Should not need PGRs, as they are naturally compact.
