Spring Outdoor Finish: Do not finish outside

For pots 6" and smaller, pinch at transplanting only. For hanging baskets and pots larger than 6", soft pinch at planting and additional pinches as needed. Sumagic® at 2-5 ppm has been effective at controlling growth.

Early drench with Bonzi causes lighter growth from center and prevents need of late season pinching. The application of Bonzi prevents the need for a secondary pinch, and therefore the energy is channeled into earlier blooms.
